## MICHAEL WOOD

For more than 20 years historian and broadcaster Michael Wood has made compelling journeys into the past, which have brought history alive for a generation of readers and viewers. He is the author of several highly praised books including *In Search of the Trojan War*, *The Domesday Quest*, *A South Indian Journey*, and *In Search of Shakespeare*. He has over 80 documentary films to his name, among them *Art of the Western World*, *In the Footsteps of Alexander the Great*, *Conquistadors* and *In Search of Myths and Heroes*. His latest documentary series *The Story of India* is on BBC2 throughout September 2007 and there is a book of the same name to accompany the television programmes. Michael was born in Manchester and educated at Manchester Grammar School and Oriel College Oxford, where he did post-graduate research in Anglo-Saxon history. He is a fellow of the Royal Historical Society and a Governor of the RSC.
